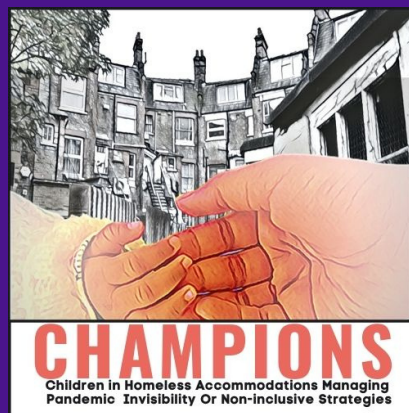


# ALL ABOUT COMMUNITY- BASED HEALTH INSURANCE (CBHI)



**CHAMPIONS** looked for cost-effective real world evidence from LMICs to reach children under 5 in temporary accommodation in the **UK**

CBHI: community members pool resources to offset healthcare costs & unpredictable events - all with a non-profit objective

Due to the use of mosquito nets and deworming in rural **Uganda**

**Increase** in prevention of mother to child transmissions of HIV

**Improved** self-reported medical care for under 5s

CBHI found to increase health seeking and child health seeking and child health utilisation in **Ethiopia** and **Burkina Faso**

Enrolment in CBHI remains a challenge

**11 countries of sub-saharan Africa**

50%

CBHI remained less than 50% post-2010

Reported coverage was 25% or lower in **8 countries**

25%

80%

However, enrolment was more than 80% in **Rwanda**

Major reasons behind success of **Rwanda** CBHI was the underlying political will through socio-economic development
