**CHAMPIONS** looked for cost-effective real world evidence from LMICs to reach children under 5 in temporary accommodation in the **UK**

**Mobile outreach services (MOS)** born of need to improve health in hard-to-reach areas

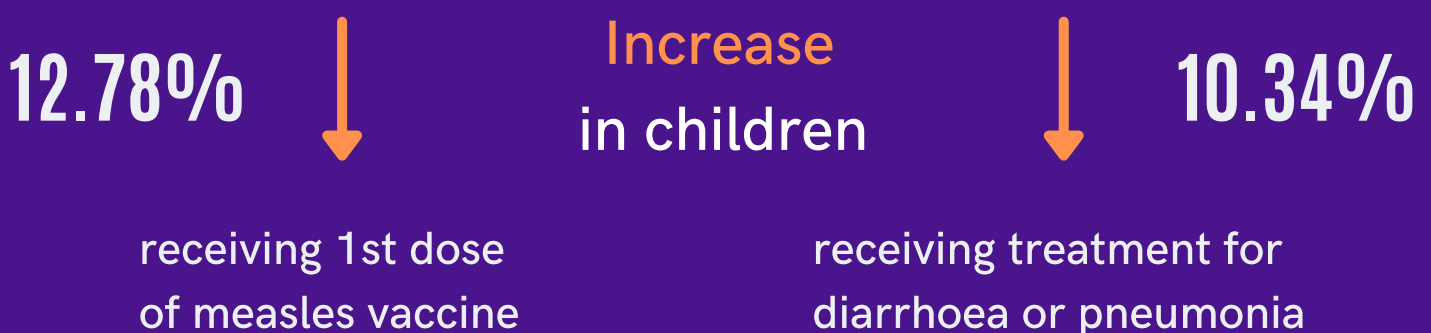


MOS give 10% minimum increase in child immunisation rate

Increased routine immunisation rate of children in **Nigeria** **17.8%** → **49%**

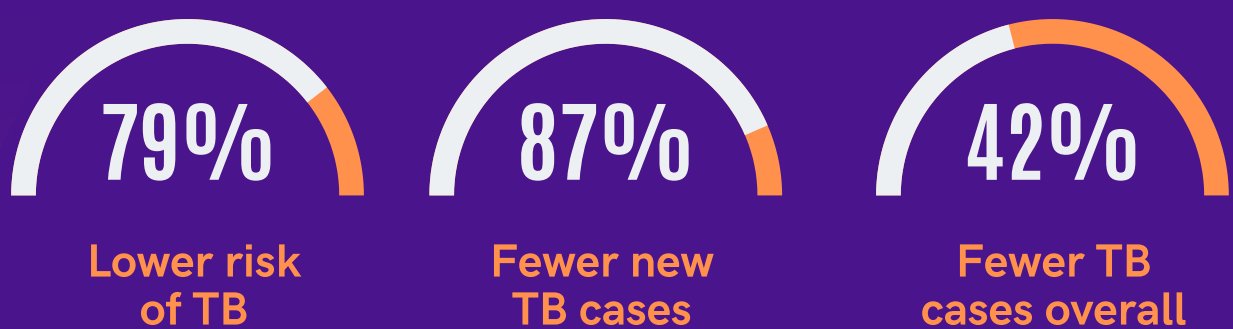
- Travelling team of health professionals - doctors, nurses, midwives
- Other health campaigns like **polio vaccination** can piggyback on
- Low-cost health camps with outreach communication campaigns can be effective

**Afghanistan:** Mobile health team consisting of midwife, generalist nurse, and someone to carry out vaccinations



Mobile team in **India** screened Tibetan refugee children and adolescents for TB and provided preventive TB care.

They also tested in boarding schools and found an extra 524 cases per 100,000. Overall led to:
